Letter from the President

To our Contributors, Colleagues and Friends

Back in 1991, the founders of Bethel World Ministries, Inc. were just setting out, looking for ways to improve the lives of desperately poor families of the Caribbean, Central and South America. Today, BWMI reaches more than 5,000 children in three countries, including Colombia, Dominican Republic and Cuba.

During these past years, we have been part of enormous progress for these children.

Only the most privileged children have a chance to go to school. Instead, most go to work as soon as they are able, condemned to lives of illiteracy and hardship. In 2007, 72 million had no access to primary school education.

Clearly, we haven't finished the job. And we won't be finished until we have brought health, education and security to every single one of these children in the Spanish speaking countries we serve.

BWMI cannot overcome all the deprivation and disasters of the world, but we asked: "Can't we do more for children in need?" So we raised the bar for ourselves: Our strategic objective for the next five years is to *triple* the number of children who benefit from our programs so entire communities, regions and nations will feel the impact of change.

Teaching the word of God

At BWMI we believe that teaching Biblical truths to our children makes a lot of practical sense. In just the past year alone we have seen a 70% improvement in the children's manners, responsibility toward others, and respect for their parents. These children are mostly abandoned or orphaned and mistreated not only by their families but by society in general.

Showing "Love in Action"

In 2009 BWMI made two trips to our compound called "Santa Rita" in Medellin, Colombia bringing with us over 1,200 lbs. of clothing and shoes on these trips for these poorest of children in that area. We also purchased food so that they would have something to eat after their bible studies and provided them with their best ever Christmas party in December. Movie projector and sound equipment was provided so that the close to 1,000 children who attend the weekly bible studies and education seminars can have the most up to date equipment that they deserve.

Santiago, Dominican Republic

Partnering with "Amor en Acción" Ministry in Santiago DR and setting up a working relationship with that city in the Dominican Republic was accomplished last year. Out of this relationship and with the help of government grants we expect to initiate projects such as an HIV clinic for the part of the population which for one reason or another cannot get help from the local government.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2009**

1) NATURE OF ACTIVITIES

Ministerios Betel Mundial Inc. is a nonprofit organization authorized under Section 501 © 3 of the Internal Revenue Code. The organization is a not for profit entity duly registered under the laws of the State of Florida. It was incorporated in April 27, 2006. The Mission of the organization is to provide Christian support, food, basic health care an education to needy people throughout Latin America.

2) SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The organization uses the Cash Basis of accounting following Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP). All direct contributions are recognized as income when collected and expenses when they are paid. In-Kind Contributions are recorded as revenue at fair market value, when received and as In-kind donations (expense) at the same amount when given to clients.

3) Property and Equipment

As of December 31, 2009 the organization had no fixed assets. Operations are handled from the residence of Mr. and Mrs. Victor Jimenez.

4) Support

The Organization's support comes mostly from donations from the general public. In-Kind donations consist of shoes and clothing donated by individuals.

5) Income Taxes

The Organization is a not for profit entity exempt from income taxes under Section 501 (c) 3, of the Internal Revenue Code and classified by the Internal Revenue Service as other than a private foundation.
